Lynde Shores Conservation Area, Whitby
 More than 670 acres, the Lynde Shores Conservation Area is well known for its wildlife viewing opportunities. Lynde Creek Marsh and Cranberry Marsh are designated provincially significant and offer extremely important wetlands to many wildlife species, including birds, amphibians, reptiles, mammals and wetland plant life. The wetlands provide habitat for many species while the adjacent upland areas are critical to a variety of water-dependent wildlife, and many woodlot and ground-nesting birds.
