Charlottenburgh Park & Cooper Marsh, Cornwall
 Today, covering more than 530 acres and renowned as one of the most significant wildlife habitats in Ontario, Charlottenburgh Park was once a lowland area periodically used for farming. Cooper Marsh's wetland and surrounding upland acres offer a diversified habitat that attracts over 130 species of birds along with a large variety of other wildlife and insects.
